

Georgia Secretary of State Website Concerns

Over the last year, Georgia Secretary of State Brian Kemp's office has implemented and upgraded to a “new and improved” website. Due to technical issues in the migration of the new system with the old, the new website is experiencing its fair share of hiccups.

The Secretary of State’s office is processing substantially all filings correctly; however, in some instances the updated information is not being reflected accurately or in a timely manner on the new site. The Corporations Division migrated millions of historical records to the new system, but information for some entities may still be incomplete due to data integrity issues and formatting irregularities. As a result, when performing online entity searches, filing online annual reports or even requesting online documents you may find incorrect or missing data related to your entity.

Since the inconsistencies on the Secretary of State’s website are related to the migration of the two systems and not to processing, these errors can be easily corrected by contacting the Corporations Division at 404-656-2817.

Coincidentally, it is not unusual for small and rural counties to take as long as 6 months for real estate activity to be updated online, even though deed filings, transfers of ownership and other related transactions have been recorded correctly.
